Launched at the Paris Opera Ballet School in 2013, on the 300<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the School, the *Summer Intensive Program* has been enjoying an increasing interest and success over the years.

Since 2016, a reciprocal program allowing for young dancers from the Paris Opera Ballet School to participate in the Summer Program in schools all over the world including in the United States, at the San Francisco Ballet School and since 2017, at the Boston Ballet School, the Houston Ballet School and Northwest Pacific School.

From its creation, the American Friends of the Paris Opera & Ballet has been willing to be involved and support this program by providing scholarships to French and American students. Based on the enthusiastic testimonies from the candidates it has become one of AFPOB's permanent programs.

# Presentation of the Paris Opera Ballet School Summer Intensive Program

The students are between 10 and 19 years old (from 6 different levels: *Junior, Elementaire* 1 and 2, *Intermediaire, Moyen 1 et 2, Avance, Superieur and Superieur PRO)* and are divided into nine to ten different levels according to age and abilities.

Girls and boys of the same level take the same classes, except for sex-specific disciplines (pointe shoes technique and boys' technique).

Tuitions depend on the length of the summer intensive (1 or 2 weeks), the level and the residential option (meals and accommodation), can cost up to 1,932 euros for 2 weeks.

The Summer School faculty includes teachers and pianists from the Paris Opera School and dancers from the Paris Opera Company.

At the end of the Summer School, parents and guardians are invited to the *Démonstrations* (final performance) to have an insight of the progressions made by the students.

## A more and more selective program

The growing success of this Summer Intensive implies that the selection has to be more and more demanding and strict.


Ms. Elisabeth Platel – The Paris Opera Ballet School Director – is doing the selections.

For 2 weeks, the Summer Intensive Program offers a unique opportunity to train, be exposed to and benefit from, the technics of the Paris Opera Ballet, studying French ballet at the oldest ballet school in the world. # 2. THE EXCHANGE SUMMER INTENSIVE PROGRAM IN THE US

In 2019, the Paris Opera Ballet School renewed its exchange program partnerships with the following American Ballet schools in order to reinforce the links with:

- The San Francisco Ballet School (3 weeks) 4 US students vs 2 French students (duration)
- The Pacific Northwest Ballet School in Seattle (2 weeks) 2 US students vs 2 French students
- The Houston Ballet Academy (2 weeks) 3 US students vs 1 French student
- The Boston Ballet School (2weeks) 2 US students vs 2 French students

The **selection of the students** chosen to participate to the 2019 Summer Intensive was based on the following criteria:

- **Wishing list:** The 4 students were particularly interested in the Trainee Program offered by the SFBS (including a possibility to audition at the end of the summer intensive)
- Teachers appreciations and assessments: a merit-based selection
- Age and career plan: 3 students already passed their state diploma and are staring their professional career.




Dear Melíte,
